Chef / Trainer / Carer

We have a vacancy for a chef who is keen to train and support adults with learning disabilities in developing catering skills. The ALFA Training Lunch Club has been running in Redland since 2013. 4 adults with learning disabilities work alongside 2 chefs to produce a 3 course meal for a group of elderly guests who live alone. The person appointed will need to:

- be competent in a range of catering skills and ideally have a Food Hygiene certificate.
- have a good understanding of the Health and Safety risks in a catering environment
- be helpful and empathetic towards people with disabilities; some experience of this client group is essential
- be flexible and adaptable

The Role:

- Based in Redland, Bristol, offering a day service to adults with learning disabilities.
- One day per week, Tuesdays.
- Pay rate £11.83 / hr. 7 hrs per day.
- Will require safeguarding training, and other training as appropriate.
- Will require an enhanced DBS check.
